



# Terms and Conditions for Yuri Method Foundation

Welcome to the Yuri Method website (the "Site"). These Terms and Conditions ("Terms") govern your access to and use of the services provided by Yuri Method Foundation, a Washington state non-profit corporation and a Section 501(c)(3) tax-exempt organization.

By accessing or using our Site and services, you agree to comply with and be bound by these Terms.

## 1. Non-Profit Mission and Purpose

The **Yuri Method Foundation** is dedicated to expanding access to academic, leadership, and scientific research opportunities for young scholars. By using this Site, you acknowledge that our services—including hands-on labs, research fellowships, and curriculum—are provided in furtherance of this charitable and educational mission

## 2. Charitable Donations and Contributions

Your support helps us provide elite academic and research opportunities to the young scholars who need them most.

**2.1 Voluntary Nature:** All donations made through the Site are voluntary and directly support our mission. Once processed, donations are non-refundable\*\*, \*\* except in the case of a clear processing error.

**2.2 Tax-Deductibility:** The Yuri Method Foundation is a registered 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. Contributions may be tax-deductible to the extent allowed by law; however, we make no representation as to the specific tax consequences for individual donors. Please consult with a tax professional regarding your specific situation.

**2.3 Receipts:** We will provide a written acknowledgment and tax receipt for all donations exceeding IRS thresholds. Please ensure your contact information is accurate to ensure timely delivery of these documents.

## 3. Programs, Registrations, and Fees

While some of our initiatives are fully subsidized for underserved populations, other programs may require a registration fee.

- **Fees vs. Donations:** Registration fees paid for services rendered are generally not considered tax-deductible donations.
- **Usage of Funds:** Fees collected are used directly to cover the operational costs of the program and the organization's broader mission.
- **Cancellations:** Program-specific cancellation and refund policies apply at the time of registration.

#### 4. Intellectual Property and Educational Use

All content, including but not limited to the "Yuri Method" curriculum, lab manuals, research methodologies, and trademarks, is the proprietary property of **Yuri Method LLC** and is used by the **Yuri Method Foundation** under a specific licensing agreement.

- **Limited License:** Yuri Method Foundation grants Site users a limited, non-exclusive, non-transferable license to access and use these materials for personal, non-commercial educational purposes in furtherance of our mission.
- **Restrictions:** This license does not transfer any ownership rights. Any unauthorized reproduction, distribution, or creation of derivative works for commercial gain is strictly prohibited without express written permission from the IP owner, Yuri Method LLC.

#### 5. Participation of Minors

Our programs are designed for students aged 4–15.

- **Guardian Requirement:** All registrations, waivers, and financial transactions must be completed by a parent or legal guardian.
- **Waivers:** By registering a minor, you represent that you have the legal authority to do so and agree to the accompanying Liability Waiver and Code of Conduct.

#### 6. Prohibited Activities and IRS Compliance

As a 501(c)(3) organization, Yuri Method Foundation is strictly prohibited from participating in political campaigns. Users may not use any community features of this Site to:

- Promote or oppose specific political candidates or parties.
- Engage in substantial lobbying activities.
- Perform any action that could jeopardize the organization's tax-exempt status.

#### 7. Volunteer and Instructor Disclaimer

Yuri Method Foundation utilizes volunteers to support its mission. Pursuant to the Volunteer Protection Act and relevant state laws, the organization and its volunteers are protected from certain liabilities while acting within the scope of their charitable responsibilities.
